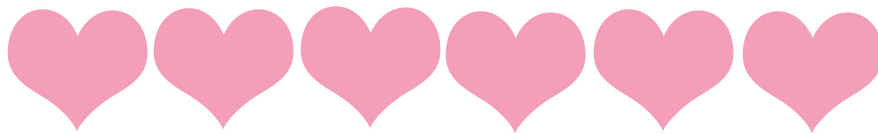


What is The SOURCE?

FREE Financial Literacy Classes

No class on April 4th and April 6th

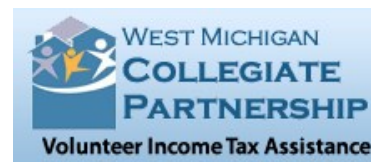

Have you ever needed help applying for health insurance for your child?

This is how a SOURCE caseworker was able to help:

An employee was referred to The SOURCE by a coworker because she needed to apply for health insurance for her child. The SOURCE caseworker was able to meet with the employee at her work to fill out the online application. After completing the application, the employee asked for assistance paying for diapers and items for the baby. The caseworker connected her with several resources close to her house that provided these items and also offered parenting classes. The employee called one of the local agencies and signed up for groups and classes aimed at mothers with young children.
